PIERE BOULEZ (1925-2016) influentially steered the course of post-war contemporary concert music through his multiple roles as groundhereaking composer (from the duzzling Le Marteau sum malter (1953) to the glittering Sur Indiese (1996)), toonotiastic conductor of many of the world's greatest orthestran, and founder of durable musical institutions in his native France (IBCAM, Cité de la musique). His provocative pronouncements cast in chiselled prose made him a botty discussed cultural figure not only in France, but worldwide.
